Instruction for Use

Disinfect and dry the field of operation. Cover the patient. Apply only to perfectly dry skin. If, for lack of time, skin is not yet dry, then use sterile swabs to dry the skin before applying the surgical incise drape.

- 1. Open the peel-bag. Remove the film under sterile conditions.
- 2. Unfold Raucodrape® over the field of operation and hold at the red edges.
- 3. Peel off the cover paper parallel to the holding edae.
- 4. Hold **Raucodrape**[®] crease-free and, starting from the centre, smooth on to the skin with a sterile cloth.
- 5. Remove **Raucodrape**[®] surgical incise drape from the patient's skin by lightly pulling at the holding edges and overstretching the film.
- 6. Do not remove $\mathbf{Raucodrape}^{\mathbb{B}}$ incise drape from the skin at an anale of 90° .

 ${f Raucodrape}^{\mbox{\it B}}$ adheres firmly even during prolonged and major operations. Sterile unless the package is opened or damaged.





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
